 - Social Distancing of 6 feet in the sanctuary and all indoor and outdoor church spaces.
 - Wearing masks when gathered in groups
 - Use the parking lot and ramp entrance/exit only.
 - Sit in pews without cushions only (marked with blue tape).
 - Family units may stay together in one pew.
 - We will have music, but robust congregational singing is discouraged; you may hum or sing very softly while masked.
 - There will be no Sunday school or Junior Church: the children are encouraged to stay in the sanctuary and worship with their church family.
 - Offerings may be placed in plates at the exits.
 - Online worship options will continue.
