

FY 2021-2022 INFORMATION FOR ST. MARK'S FOOD CENTER CLIENTS

The following information is being given to you so that you are aware of the requirements of the Temporary Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

HOURS: Tuesdays from 9:00 AM to 10:45 AM.

3rd Tuesday evening 6:00 PM to 7:30 PM.

We will be closed on fifth Tuesdays. In 2022: March 29, May 31

PLEASE CALL the Food Center at 610-325-0130 BEFORE YOU COME so we may prepare your food.
In bad weather or an emergency, the recorded message will let you know if we are open.

If you are coming in for food, leave a message with your name and SPELL YOUR LAST NAME.

**When you arrive, park in the church parking lot and look for the volunteer who is giving out numbers. Get your number then please wait in your car in bad weather.
Your number will be displayed on a chart and then you may come inside.**

You will be asked to show ID: Drivers' License, Photo ID, passport, utility bill, etc., and something with your name and address to prove residency in Delaware County.

You will be asked for size of household and ages of all members. You will then sign* a Declaration of Need Form where you state that, based on household size, the total income of all members does not exceed income guidelines and eligibility to be served.

***IF IT IS DISCOVERED THAT YOU HAVE SIGNED FALSELY,
YOU MAY BE REQUIRED TO PAY FOR ALL FOOD RECEIVED.**

YOUR FAMILY CAN ONLY BE SERVED ONCE A MONTH!

YOU MUST BE A RESIDENT OF DELAWARE COUNTY

YOU WILL RECEIVE:

- Donated baked goods, frozen meat and fish, cheese and butter when available
- A set of filled grocery bags, the number depending on the size of your family
 - A "mystery" bag filled with food and other surprises!
 - Giant gift cards when available

If you need more than the one-week's worth of food we give, we will give you the names and locations of other food pantries. We strongly suggest you apply for SNAP (food stamps/EBT) benefits if you meet eligibility requirements.
